ON THE CASE OF CONFORMITY OF THE OBLIGATIONS STIPULATED BY THE AGREEMENT ON ENCOURAGING INVESTMENTS AND MUTUAL DEFENSE SIGNED BETWEEN THE GOVERNMENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA AND THE GOVERNMENT OF THE UNITED ARAB EMIRATES ON JULY 22, 2016 IN YEREVAN WITH THE CONSTITUTION OF THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA

Proceeding from the results of examination of the case and ruled by Article 100(2), Parts 1 and 4, Article 102, of the Constitution of the Republic of Armenia, Articles 63, 64 and 72 of the RA Law on Constitutional Court, the Constitutional Court of the Republic of Armenia **HOLDS**:

- 1. The obligations stipulated by the Agreement on Encouraging Investments and Mutual Defense signed between the Government of the Republic of Armenia and the Government of the United Arab Emirates on July 22, 2016 in Yerevan, are in conformity with the Constitution of the Republic of Armenia.
- 2. In accordance with Article 102(2) of RA Constitution this decision is final and enters into force from the moment of its announcement.
