ON THE CASE OF CONFORMITY OF THE OBLIGATIONS STIPULATED BY THE AGREEMENT (SIGNED ON 13 OCTOBER 2016 IN YEREVAN) ON THE ORDER OF CONTROL OVER AVAILABILITY AND TARGET USE OF MILITARY SUPPLIES PROVIDED UNDER THE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA AND THE RUSSIAN FEDERATION ON DEVELOPMENT OF MILITARY-TECHNICAL COOPERATION WITH THE CONSTITUTION OF THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA

Based on the review of the Case, the legal positions expressed in this Case, and being governed by Point 2 of Article 100, Parts 1 and 4 of Article 102 of the Constitution of the Republic of Armenia (with Amendments through 2005), Articles 63, 64 and 72 of the Law of the Republic of Armenia on the Constitutional Court, the Constitutional Court of the Republic of Armenia **HOLDS**:

- The obligations stipulated by the Agreement (signed on 13 October 2016 in Yerevan) on the Order of Control over Availability and Target Use of Military Supplies provided under the Agreement between the Republic of Armenia and the Russian Federation on Development of Military-technical Cooperation, are in conformity with the Constitution of the Republic of Armenia.
- 2. Pursuant to Part 2 of Article 102 of the Constitution of the Republic of Armenia this Decision is final and enters into force from the moment of the announcement.
