DECISION OF THE CONSTITUTIONAL COURT OF
THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA**

**ON THE CASE OF CONFORMITY OF THE OBLIGATIONS STIPULATED BY THE
AGREEMENT ON THE STATUS OF INTERNATIONAL CENTRE FOR MIGRATION
POLICY DEVELOPMENT (ICMPD) SIGNED IN YEREVAN ON 15 NOVEMBER 2016
BETWEEN THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA AND THE INTERNATIONAL CENTRE FOR
MIGRATION POLICY DEVELOPMENT (ICMPD) WITH THE CONSTITUTION OF THE
REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA**

Based on the review of the Case and being governed by Point 2 of Article 100, Parts 1 and 4 of Article 102 of the Constitution of the Republic of Armenia (with Amendments through 2005), Articles 63, 64 and 72 of the Law of the Republic of Armenia on the Constitutional Court, the Constitutional Court of the Republic of Armenia **HOLDS:**

1. The obligations stipulated by the Agreement on the Status of International Centre for Migration Policy Development (ICMPD) signed in Yerevan on 15 November 2016 between the Republic of Armenia and the International Centre for Migration Policy Development (ICMPD) are in conformity with the Constitution of the Republic of Armenia.
2. Pursuant to Part 2 of Article 102 of the Constitution of the Republic of Armenia this Decision is final and enters into force from the moment of the announcement.
