**ON THE CASE OF CONFORMITY OF THE OBLIGATIONS  
STIPULATED BY THE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE REPUBLIC OF  
ARMENIA AND THE NATO SUPPORT AND PROCUREMENT  
ORGANIZATION ON SUPPORT COOPERATION SIGNED JULY 14,  
2017 IN LUXEMBOURG AND BRUSSELS WITH THE CONSTITUTION  
OF THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA**

Proceeding from the results of consideration of the case and ruled by Point 2 of Article 100, Parts 1 and 4 of Article 102 of the Constitution of the Republic of Armenia, Articles 63, 64 and 72 of the RA Law on Constitutional Court, the Constitutional Court of the Republic of Armenia HOLDS:

1. The obligations set out in the Agreement signed on July 14, 2017 in Luxembourg and Brussels between the Republic of Armenia and the NATO Support and Procurement Organization on Support Cooperation are in conformity with the RA Constitution.

2. In accordance with Article 102 (2) of the RA Constitution this decision is final and enters into force from the moment of its announcement.
