ON THE CASE OF CONFORMITY OF THE OBLIGATIONS STIPULATED IN AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE GOVERNMENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA AND THE GOVERNMENT OF THE RUSSIAN FEDERATION ON THE STATE EXPORT CREDIT TO THE GOVERNMENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA, SIGNED ON 24 OCTOBER 2017 IN YEREVAN WITH THE CONSTITUTION OF THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA

Based on the review of the Case and governed by Point 2 of Article 100, and Article 102 of the Constitution of the Republic of Armenia (with Amendments through 2005), Articles 63 and 64 of the Law of the Republic of Armenia on the Constitutional Court, the Constitutional Court of the Republic of Armenia **HOLDS**:

- 1. The obligations stipulated in Agreement between the Government of the Republic of Armenia and the Government of the Russian Federation on the State Export Credit to the Government of the Republic of Armenia, signed on 24 October 2017 in Yerevan are in conformity with the Constitution of the Republic of Armenia.
- 2. Pursuant to Part 2 of Article 102 of the Constitution of the Republic of Armenia (with Amendments through 2005) this Decision is final and enters into force from the moment of the announcement.
