DECISION OF THE CONSTITUTIONAL COURT OF  
THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA**

**ON THE CASE OF CONFORMITY OF THE OBLIGATIONS STIPULATED BY THE AGREEMENT ON COOPERATION IN COMBATING CRIME SIGNED BETWEEN THE GOVERNMENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA AND THE GOVERNMENT OF CZECH REPUBLIC IN PRAGUE ON 30 JANUARY 2014 WITH THE CONSTITUTION OF THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA**

Proceeding from the results of examination of the case and ruled by Articles 168 (para.3) and 170 (para.1 and 4) of the Constitution of the Republic of Armenia and Articles 63, 64 and 74 of the RA Law on Constitutional Court, the Constitutional Court of the Republic of Armenia **HOLDS:**

1. The obligations stipulated by the Agreement on Cooperation in Combating Crime signed between the Government of the Republic of Armenia and the Government of Czech Republic in Prague on 30 January 2014 are in conformity with the Constitution of the Republic of Armenia.
2. In accordance with Article 170 (2) of RA Constitution this decision is final and enters into force from the moment of its announcement.
