

**IN THE NAME OF THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA
DECISION OF THE CONSTITUTIONAL COURT OF
THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA**

ON THE CASE OF CONFORMITY OF THE OBLIGATIONS STIPULATED IN THE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE GOVERNMENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA AND THE GOVERNMENT OF THE RUSSIAN FEDERATION ON INFORMATION-SHARING AND EXCHANGE OF INFORMATION VIA ELECTRONIC MEANS ON ISSUES CONCERNING THE JURISDICTION OF THE POLICE OF THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA AND THE BODIES OF INTERNAL AFFAIRS OF THE RUSSIAN FEDERATION SIGNED IN MOSCOW ON 13 MAY 2021 WITH THE CONSTITUTION

Based on the review of the case and governed by Clause 3 of Article 168, Parts 1 and 4 of Article 170 of the Constitution, as well as Articles 63, 64 and 74 of the Constitutional Law on the Constitutional Court, the Constitutional Court **HOLDS:**

1. The obligations stipulated in the Agreement between the Government of the Republic of Armenia and the Government of the Russian Federation on Information-Sharing and Exchange of Information Via Electronic Means on Issues Concerning the Jurisdiction of the Police of the Republic of Armenia and the Bodies of Internal Affairs of the Russian Federation signed in Moscow on 13 May 2021 are in conformity with the Constitution.

2. Pursuant to Part 2 of Article 170 of the Constitution this Decision shall be final and shall enter into force upon its promulgation.
