DECISION OF THE CONSTITUTIONAL COURT OF
THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA**

ON THE CASE CONCERNING THE DETERMINATION OF THE ISSUE OF CONFORMITY OF THE OBLIGATIONS STIPULATED BY THE AGREEMENT ON MUTUAL ADMINISTRATIVE ASSISTANCE IN CUSTOMS MATTERS SIGNED ON 15 OCTOBER 2007, IN YEREVAN BETWEEN THE GOVERNMENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA AND THE GOVERNMENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF GEORGIA WITH THE CONSTITUTION OF THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA

Considering the results of the examination of the case and guided by Article 100 (2), Parts 2 and 4, Article 102 of the Constitution, Articles 63, 64 and 72 of the Law on "The Constitutional Court," the Constitutional Court of the Republic of Armenia **DECIDES:**

1. The obligations, stipulated by the Agreement on Mutual Administrative Assistance in Customs Matters signed on 15 October 2007 in Yerevan between the Government of the Republic of Armenia and the Government of the Republic of Georgia, are in conformity with the Constitution of the Republic of Armenia.
2. Pursuant to Part 2, Article 102 of the RA Constitution this decision is final and enters into force from the date of publication.
