DECISION OF THE CONSTITUTIONAL COURT OF
THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA

ON THE CASE CONCERNING THE DETERMINATION OF THE ISSUE REGARDING THE CONFORMITY OF THE OBLIGATIONS STIPULATED BY THE PROTOCOL ON TRAINING OF THE PERSONNEL OF THE ARMED FORCES OF THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA IN THE MILITARY EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTIONS AND TRAINING CENTERS OF THE NATIONAL DEFENSE MINISTRY OF THE HELLENIC REPUBLIC SIGNED ON 10 NOVEMBER 2008 IN ATHENS BETWEEN THE DEFENSE MINISTRY OF THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA AND THE NATIONAL DEFENSE MINISTRY OF THE HELLENIC REPUBLIC WITH THE CONSTITUTION OF THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA

Considering the results of the examination of the case and ruled by Article 100 (2), Parts 2 and 4 Article 102 of the Constitution, Articles 63 and 64 of the RA Law on “The Constitutional Court”, the Constitutional Court of the Republic of Armenia **DECIDES:**

1. The obligations, stipulated by the Protocol on Training of the Personnel of the Armed Forces of the Republic of Armenia in the Military Educational Institutions and Training Centers of the National Defense Ministry of the Hellenic Republic signed on 10 November 2008 in Athens between the Defense Ministry of the Republic of Armenia and the National Defense Ministry of the Hellenic Republic, are in conformity with the Constitution of the Republic of Armenia.
2. Pursuant to Part 2, Article 102 of the RA Constitution this decision is final and enters into force from the date of publication.
