

**IN THE NAME OF THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA
DECISION OF THE CONSTITUTIONAL COURT OF
THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA**

ON THE CASE CONCERNING THE DETERMINATION OF THE ISSUE REGARDING THE CONFORMITY OF THE OBLIGATIONS STIPULATED BY THE PROTOCOL No.5 ON MAKING CHANGES IN THE AGREEMENT ON THE RUSSIAN MILITARY BASE IN THE TERRITORY OF THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA BETWEEN THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA AND THE RUSSIAN FEDERATION SIGNED ON 16 MARCH 1995, BETWEEN THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA AND THE RUSSIAN FEDERATION SIGNED ON 20 AUGUST 2010 IN YEREVAN WITH THE CONSTITUTION OF THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA

Proceeding from the results of hearing of the case and ruled by Article 100(2), Parts 2 and 4, Article 102 of the Constitution, Articles 63, 64 and 72 of the Law on Constitutional Court, the Constitutional Court of the Republic of Armenia **DECIDES:**

1. The obligations, set forth in the Protocol No.5 on Making Changes in the Agreement on the Russian Military Base in the Territory of the Republic of Armenia between the Republic of Armenia and the Russian Federation signed on 16 March 1995, signed on 20 August 2010 in Yerevan between the Republic of Armenia and the Russian Federation, are in conformity with the Constitution of the Republic of Armenia.
2. In accordance with Part 2, Article 102 of the Constitution of the Republic of Armenia this decision is final and enters into force from the moment of announcement.
