

**IN THE NAME OF THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA
DECISION OF THE CONSTITUTIONAL COURT OF
THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA**

ON THE CASE CONCERNING THE DETERMINATION OF THE ISSUE REGARDING THE CONFORMITY OF ARTICLES 1 AND 4 OF THE LAW OF THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA "ON VETERANS OF THE GREAT PATRIOTIC WAR" AND THE DECISION #207-N OF THE GOVERNMENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA DATED 5 FEBRUARY 2004 WITH THE CONSTITUTION OF THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA ON THE BASED ON THE APPLICATION FILED BY THE DEFENDER OF HUMAN RIGHTS OF RA

Proceeding from the results of examination of the case and ruled by article 100(1), article 102 of the Constitution of the Republic of Armenia, article 60(2), articles 63, 64 and 68 of the RA Law on Constitutional Court, the Constitutional Court of the Republic of Armenia **DECIDES:**

1. Articles 1 and 4 of the RA Law on Veterans of the Great Patriotic War are in conformity with the Constitution of the Republic of Armenia.
2. To declare the decision N 207-N of the Government of the Republic of Armenia dated 27 February 2004, in regard to the non-stipulation of the realization order of the rights of the persons, mentioned in part 2.3 of the appendix of the Agreement on Mutual Recognition of the Privileges and Guarantees Granted to Great Patriotic War Disabled and Participants, Participants of Combat Actions on an Alien Soil, and Families of Fallen Military signed within the framework of CIS on 15 April 1994 and entered into force for the Republic of Armenia from 26 February 1996, and in regard to the isolation of these rights, as contradicting to Article 3, Part 2, Article 85, Part 2 and Article 43, Part 2 of the Constitution of the Republic of Armenia, considering the legal positions expressed in the Points 6 and 7 of the explanatory part of this decision and taking into consideration the decision N 668-N of the RA Government dated 5 May 2011.
3. In accordance with article 102(2) of RA Constitution this decision is final and enters into force from the moment of announcement.
